



## 15 Hours Extended CHILDCARE for working parents at Suffolks Primary School!

★ For All 3 & 4 Year Olds ★

Eligible working families can get an additional 15 hours (making 30 total).

You may qualify if you (and your partner, if you have one):

- ✓ are working or starting a new job
- ✓ are on sick leave, annual leave, maternity/paternity/adoption leave

Income Requirements (over 3 months) - you must each expect to earn at least:

- £2,539.68 (age 21+) (equivalent to £195.36 per week)
- £2,080 (age 18–20) (equivalent to £160 per week)
- £1,570.40 (under 18 or apprentice) (equivalent to £120.80 per week)

This equals 16 hours per week at minimum wage.

### 🌱 How to Get Your 15-Hour Extended Childcare Code

You can apply up to 16 weeks before your child turns 3. Apply at least 6 weeks before the deadline to avoid delays!

You'll need:

- Your National Insurance number
- Your work start date
- Any benefits/support you receive
- Your child's birth certificate number (if available)

After applying, you'll get an 11-digit code. Bring this code to us along with:

- your child's date of birth
- your National Insurance number


👉 Remember: Reconfirm your details every 3 months.

<b>If my child turns 3 years old between</b>	<b>I need to apply by</b>	<b>And I can access the extended 15 hours form</b>
1 January to 31 March	31-Mar	Term starting on or after 1 April
1 April to 31 August	31-Aug	Term starting on or after 1 September
1 September to 31 December	31-Dec	Term starting on or after 1 January
