Pupil premium funding is additional money that is given to schools to address inequalities between those children who are eligible for Free School Meals and their peers. For each child who is eligible to receive free school meals, the school receives £1,300.

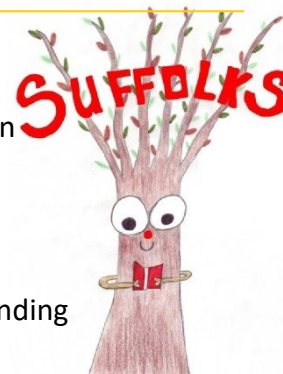
