All year groups to teach reflect, rewind and replay at the end of the term plus at least 3 other units.

During in class singing assemblies (KS1/KS2 rotating each half term)- teachers to work through learning the song and the listen and appraise element of the charanga program. This incorporates the interrelated dimensions of music, music appreciation and development of musical vocabulary. This will also mean less time is needed in the summer term to teach the song and classes can focus on the composition and response element.
