

SUFFOLKS PRIMARY HOME/SCHOOL AGREEMENT (SEPT 2020)



The Child

I will do my best to:

- Make sure that I wash before I come to school.
- Wear clean uniform to school every day.
- Wear my PE kit to school on PE day
- Listen to the school adults and make sure that I follow the instructions they give to help keep me safe.
- Wash my hands for at least 20 seconds and use hand sanitizer when I am told to by adults.
- Not put toys or equipment into my mouth.
- Help to keep the adults and children safe by trying not to get too close to them.
- Tell a school adult if I do not feel well.

At Suffolks we will be doing the best we can to get the balance between keeping our children safe as well as ensuring they are happy and confident to come to school. We will encourage children to keep their distance from adults, but if needed to, adults will comfort children and be closer than the social distancing expectations to support their wellbeing.

Staff will be encouraged to wear masks when working closely with the children, but as the guidance states that it is not expected, we will be allowing staff to choose if they would prefer to wear one.

The family

- *Tell the school immediately if any member of your household shows signs of Covid 19 and is self isolating.*
- *Make sure that your child wears clean uniform to school each day.*
- *Stay with your child and keep them close to you until they go into class*
- *Keep your distance from other people and wear masks when on the school site*
- *Ensure you leave the school premises as soon as possible and do not congregate at the school gates.*
- *Help to explain all the new procedures to your child so they are prepared to attend school.*
- *Ensure you collect your child from school on time.*
- *Work positively with the school as guidelines and circumstances change.*
- *Refrain from using your mobile phone at drop off and collection times to ensure that you can focus on safety procedures.*

No parents will be allowed to enter the school building for any reason, without a pre-arranged appointment.

Communication with parents will only be via phone or email.

The school must have your current contact details.

Please make sure that you update the school office if any of your details have changed.

The school will:

- Put in place Covid secure procedures to better ensure the safety of staff, parents and children.
- Take the temperatures of all children before they enter the building. (Children will not be allowed in school with a temperature higher than 37.5°C)
- Provide hand sanitiser and ensure children use it on entry to school and at any time they leave or enter their classroom.
- Inform parents as soon as possible, if a case of Covid 19 has been confirmed or suspected.
- Inform parents as soon as possible, if we have to close due to a confirmed case of Covid 19.
- Inform parents as soon as possible, if we have to close due to staff numbers reducing due to illness.
- Support all staff and families with testing if necessary, and ensure that they self isolate for the agreed time before returning to school.
- Continue to use 'Google Classroom' to assign homework for all children and to implement home learning if the school is closed for any reason.
- Care for your child at all times to ensure that they feel safe and happy at school.
