School Uniform

We ask that all children wear our school uniform as detailed below. Please encourage them to take pride in their appearance

- School embroidered polo shirt (yellow)
- School sweatshirt or cardigan (royal blue)
- Trousers or skirt (grey) Children in Nursery, Reception or Year 1 can wear jogging bottoms (royal blue)
- Black shoes
- In summer a checked dress may be worn (blue and white)
- Headdress worn for religious reasons (royal blue, dark grey or navy)

PE Kit (not required for Nursery)

- House colour T-shirt (you will be advised of which house your child is apart of)
- Plain Navy or Black shorts
- Plimsolls or trainers (any colour as bright as you like)
- Jogging bottoms or tracksuits for winter (any colour)

You will also need a PE bag and a book bag.

For safety reasons no jewellery (other than plain stud earrings) is allowed in school. If a watch is worn it should be flat and without alarms. Permission from the Headteacher will be required if you would like your child to wear jewellery for any other particle religious or medical reason.

School Dinners and Packed Lunches.

Your child may have a school lunch, bring a packed lunch or choose to go home for lunch.

Our kitchens provide a daily choice of appetising and nutritious meals. These are cooked on site in our own kitchens and are served in our dining hall.

If you are in receipt of benefit you may be eligible for free school meals, either a cooked meal or school packed lunch. We urge you to apply for these even if your child prefers a packed lunch from home.

Some families prefer their children to bring a packed lunch, in which case we would ask that the food is adequate to sustain a growing child. As a school we promote healthy eating and therefore ask that sweets and chocolate are not included in packed lunches. Drinks should be in a plastic container, or carton. Each child should have a lunch box with his/her name and class clearly marked. These are stored on trolleys until lunchtime.

Dinner money should be paid through ParentPay or at a PayPoint. Parents wishing to pay termly / half termly will be given prior notice of the amount due and credits are allowed if your child is absent.
