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| Science We have a physics focus this term in science. We will start off by looking at the different states of matter and how particles react in different conditions. We build upon this knowledge in the second part of the term when we begin to study sound including how we hear them and making sounds louder and quieter. | PSHE This term our Jigsaw units are Being Me and Celebrating Differences. We will be looking at how our actions can affect others, how we can work together to solve problems. We will also be looking at how we are all unique and celebrate our differences. | RE Christianity: children will learn not only about religion but from religion; the focus is not only on Christianity but children will be able to draw from other religions and their own beliefs and practices. Children will be able to identify similarities across religions with a great focus on how people from religious and non-religious communities celebrate key festivals. | French We will be learning how to describe things in French. The children will learn that adjectives can change if the noun is masculine or feminine. We will then use these to practice describing clothes in French. There are some fantastic free resources on the internet to help children remember what they have learned. |
| PE Dance: The children will be practicing routines to different themes such as 'The Spy' and 'Carnival'. Fundamentals and Fitness: They will be practicing skills such as balancing, changing direction and speed when running and building their stamina and strength. | History Our history topic is Ancient Civilisations with a focus on 'What inventions can we thank the Ancient Civilisations for?' Children will learn about Writing systems, Trade, Maths and numbers, Technology and inventions and Buildings and structures (Ancient wonders of the world). | DT Fashion/Textiles: children will be exploring and analysing different ways to join fabrics together. They will be using a range of stitches, pattern pieces and decorative elements to produce a seasonal stocking which they will then evaluate. | Art Drawing: children will learn a variety of shading and sketching techniques whilst making careful observations to draw self portraits and how to create a 3-dimensional drawing by using different techniques. They will also be exploring photographic techniques. |
