English writing The children will continue to develop their writing skills such as handwriting, spelling and grammar through lessons on top of main writing lessons. In writing lessons, children will generate ideas and vocabulary as well as use literary devices whilst developing sentence work through the narratives of 'The Nowhere Emporium' and 'Cosmic'.	English reading The children will continue to develop their reading skills such as locating information from a text; understanding character perspectives; summarising events; understanding vocabulary they come across and much more. They will do this through a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts such as myths, stories, biographies, recipes, reports, poetry and much more.	Mathematics This term, children will learn about larger numbers up to a million. They will be counting in 10s, 100s, 1000s, 10000s and 100000s as well as rounding and learning about negative numbers. Children will secure their knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division through quick-fire recall of mental strategies and more formal written methods as well as applying these skills in puzzles, problem-solving and word problems. The children will learn of different types of numbers such as prime, square, cubed, factors and multiples. They will measure and calculate the perimeter and area of shapes. The children will extract information from tables, timetables and line graphs.
