Governing Body - Proposed priorities for 2023/24

In all areas we will work with the Senior Leadership Team and colleagues throughout the school to keep these priorities under review, to monitor progress and to take any action that may be necessary.

We are aware that events can happen during the year that will introduce new challenges and opportunities and will need to respond to these as they arise.

- 1. RAP we will monitor progress against the school's Rapid Action Plan.
- 2. Changes to the school day we will monitor the impact of changes to the school day introduced for 2023/24.
- 3. Falling rolls we will explore the impact of falling rolls on the school's organisation and budget.
- 4. Budget we will pro- actively review the 3-year budget to explore ways in which the predicted deficits can be eliminated or reduced.
- 5. Safeguarding we will continue to monitor safeguarding procedures and practice.
- 6. Resilience we will support SLT and all staff to maintain resilience and wellbeing.
- School engagement we will agree a programme of learning walks and governor visits with the school to ensure that all governors are familiar with the school and its work.
- 8. Enrichment activities these activities have been reduced as a result of budgetary constraints and family ability to contribute financially. Governors will work with the school to find ways of e.g. increasing school visits and participation in borough/London wide sports competitions.
- 9. Governor effectiveness we will review link governor roles to ensure that all key areas are adequately covered, and undertake relevant training.
